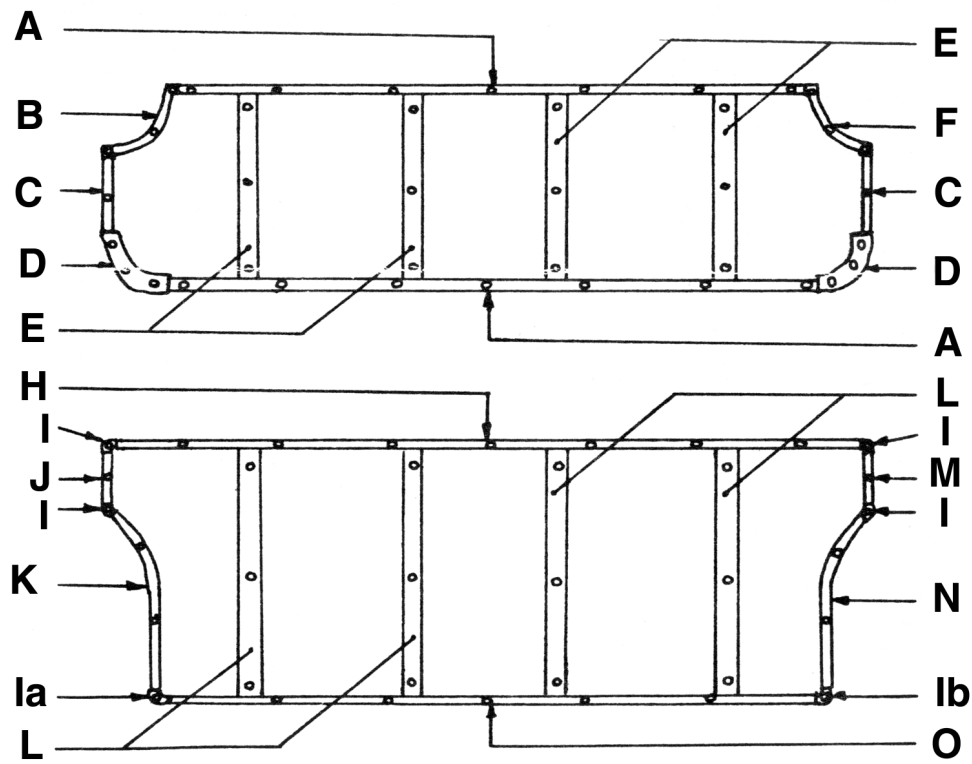

Cargo Area Trim for Safaris

One area of Safaris which is usually in need of repair and restoration is the rear interior cargo area. Some ex-Safari owners seem to have thought that the cars were designed for transporting cattle! Often the stainless and other trim pieces are gone or badly damaged. I hope these diagrams and charts will be useful to Safari lover in locating and replacing the parts for their cargo areas. The information presented here was derived from a '57 2 door Custom Safari. I imagine that the other years are different in some aspects and care should be taken in transferring this information to other years and models.

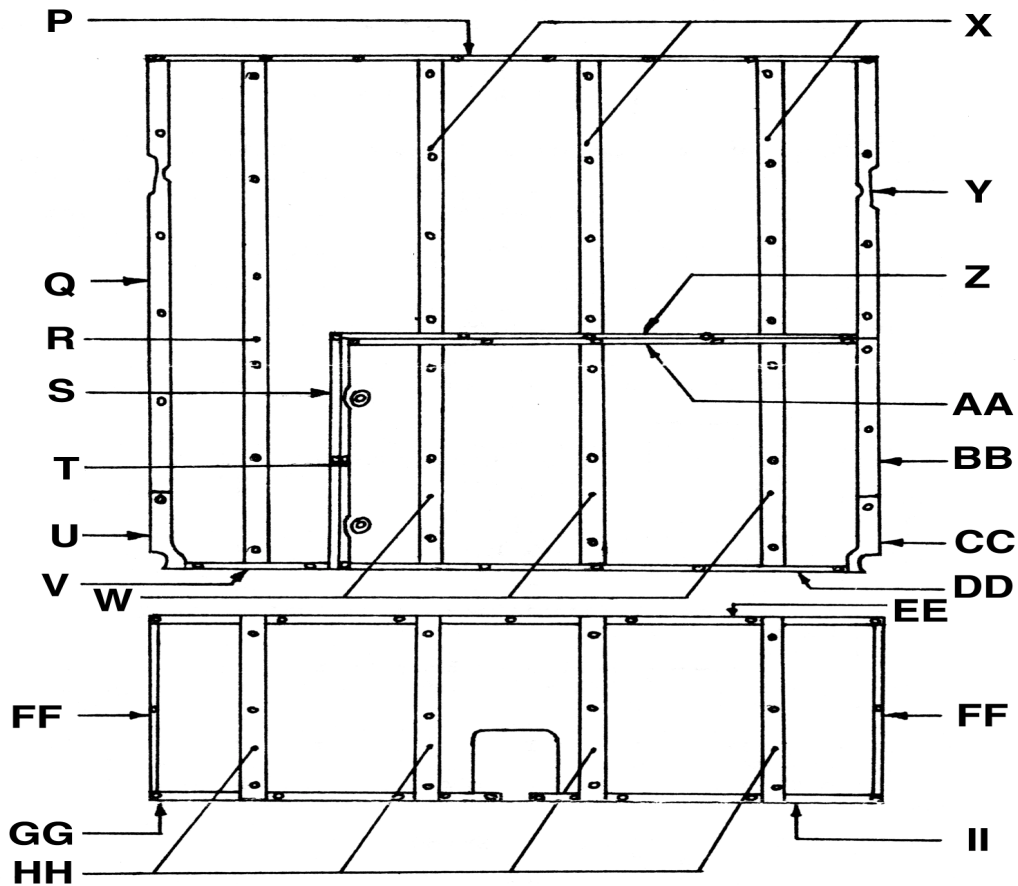


Legend for '57 Custom Safari 2 Door Seat, Cargo and Tailgate Interior Trim Pieces
